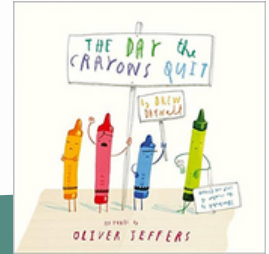

Term 1 Week 3

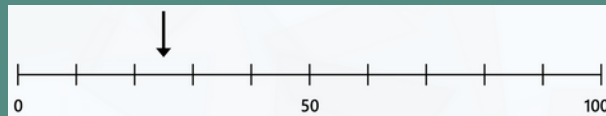


English

This week in SPAG, we were adding in missing punctuation to sentences. We recapped when we need a capital letter and what punctuation needs to go at the end of the sentence, whether it be a full stop or question. We have been loving our learning about the Crayons this week! We first thought about what each crayon would say. First, we acted some of these ideas out and your children were brilliant actors! Then the children wrote out what each crayon would say. The children started to punctuate their sentences by using exclamation marks and capital letters.

Maths

In Maths this week we have been continuing our learning of Place Value. We have been learning to estimate numbers using a number line, compare objects and amounts. We used the comparing signs ($<$, $>$ and $=$) and then the children wrote out the statements such as: 34 is less than 78 and 78 is greater than 34.



PE

This week on Monday we had our dance session. Our dance lessons are all based around plants this term, last week we were prepping the garden for seeds by digging and raking. This week, we had planted the seeds and the children were growing plants. They moved their bodies to the music, which was 'Sunshine (My Girl)', the children loved this song! Our Thursday session was our first, learning about ball skills. We were learning to roll a ball a long a line, roll the ball to hit a target and then learnt how to stop a rolling ball.

History

This was our first week learning about the Great Fire of London. We wanted to know what the children already knew about GfOL. Some children drew pictures and others wrote sentences. Next week, the children will learn about what London is like now and what it looked like in 1666.
