


<u>English</u>



In English this week, we read the next two chapters of the book The Sheep-Pig. We discussed the events of the story, used dictionaries to find the meaning of tricky words and we did some writing about the story. The children wrote a set of instructions and a diary entry from the perspective of the characters in the book.

<u>Maths</u>

In maths this week, we have learnt how to convert pounds & pence from one unit to the other. We also learnt how to add and subtract money. We will soon learn how to find change. Please help the children understand these concepts better by allowing them to handle coins and notes. Many children find this strand of maths (which is a life skill) quite tricky.
