Maths:

In maths, we have been rounding integers. We have also been solving arithmetic-style questions.

English:

We have continued to read our class book, Letters from the Lighthouse; the children answered questions based on one of the chapters.

Science:

The children carried out an investigation this week, titled: Which materials reflect light the best? They tested a variety of materials, before reaching a conclusion.

Computing:

The children were introduced to the concept of Data Packets this week. They learnt how data is transferred across the internet via networks in packets.

History:

We recapped the topic vocabulary we are using during our history lessons, before placing important dates and events in chronological order. We then used secondary sources to find out how the different countries in Europe were ruled.

Italian & Latin:
