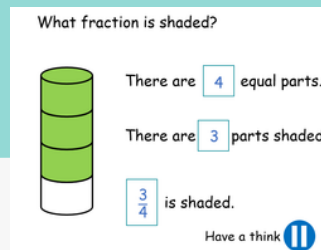
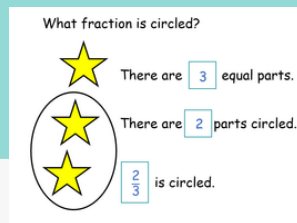

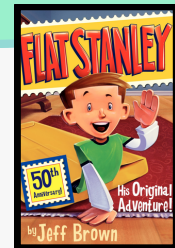
Maths

This week in Maths we have been learning about fractions. We have specifically been learning about non-unit fractions. We explored how to identify and find fractions of shapes and amounts, such as $\frac{2}{3}$ or $\frac{3}{4}$, where the numerator is greater than one.



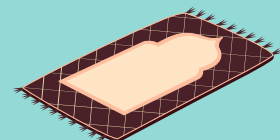
English

This week we have continued reading our chapter book Flat Stanley, we are loving seeing the adventures he has been on so far; Australia, France and Ireland.
