
Year 4 Newsletter

Maths

In Maths, the children began the week by looking at polygons. They discovered that a polygon is a 2D shape enclosed by three or more straight lines. We looked at the difference between irregular and regular polygons. Irregular polygons have sides of different lengths and angles. Regular polygons are names for other shapes with sides of the same length. These include pentagon which has 5 sides, hexagon has 6, heptagon has 7, and octagon has 8 sides.



<u>Science</u>

This week in Science, we looked again at electrical circuits, thinking carefully about why some circuits shown to the children were incomplete. Children had to correct the mistakes in the circuit and explain the errors that had been made.
