This week in maths, we have revised 2D shapes and learnt about 3D shapes. In addition to that, we worked on coordinates in the first quadrant and reflection. In English, the children considered how emotions were conveyed in a chapter of "Kensuke's Kingdom." They wrote detailed narrative, focusing on the senses, and they wrote a concise message in a bottle too. In RE, we learnt about how and why Muslims fast, and in history we began to find out about the Ancient Greeks. Linked with this, Greek vases were drawn in art. In science, after a lesson about water resistance and a brief investigation relating to streamlining, we went to sail our boats in the stream.
