YEAR ONE Neusletter

For the week of: 7th March 2022

English

In SPag this week, the children learnt the plural form of nouns ending in 'ch' and 'sh'. They practised adding —es to these nouns.

During the rest of the week we have been looking at the final parts of our non-fiction learning about Castles. We looked at what a Knight does and wears. We then looked at other jobs in a castle such as a servant, priest, cook and jester.

Maths

The children revisited what they had previously learnt in shapes and measures this week – length/ height; mass/ capacity and 2D/ 3D shapes. They solved problems based on these strands.

Later in the week we furthered our learning on place value within 50. We were identifying one more and one less and then have been comparing amounts by counting the tens and counting on the ones.

Science

In science lesson this week, we studied a wide variety of garden plants and wild plants. We learnt that wild plants that grow in places we don't want them to, are called weeds. The children then identified some common plants and illustrated them in their books.

Other

We were very excited to discover that our bean seeds have germinated and the shoots are beginning to appear this week! We will observe their growth in the next few weeks. Next week we are lucky enough to have a cricket session with a local cricket coach. This will be on Friday 18^{th} – therefore there will not be PE on Thursday. Please can the children come in on Friday in their PE kits instead!
