
## Reception Newsletter

In phonics this week the children have been building on work covered in previous weeks on the suffixes 'ing' and 'ed' in words such as: creeping, groaning, crowding and splashed, screeched, croaked. The children have also been reading the following Tricky Words: some, come, love, do,



you, said and have. It would be great if the children could review these at home too to support their learning from this week.

The children have continued to study minibeasts and the story of 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar' this week. The rest of the children loved making their fruit kebabs! The children have enjoyed tasting some different fruits and were so good at chopping very carefully with the knives.

In maths this week the children have been reviewing their knowledge of odd and even numbers. We have also been looking at doubling again, the children copied patterns on a butterfly to find doubles of numbers to 10.

It has been an exciting week in Reception as the children have been fascinated by our caterpillars becoming chrysalides and they cannot wait for the butterflies to emerge! This should happen in 7-10 days hopefully. They are being transferred into their butterfly habitat tonight!

The children are thrilled that we have one chick! Lots of excitement for us this morning! We are hoping for more to hatch. We will keep you posted!
