Creation

What do Christians learn from the Creation story?

- What are our questions and possible answers about what might be important in the creation story for Christians living today, and for people who are not Christians?

Art

In art, we will focus on sketching - using tone to create form and light and applying different shading techniques with various pencils.

Maths

Place value:

- Represent and partition numbers to 10,000
- Find 1, 10, 100, 1000 more or less
- Number line to 10.000
- Compare and order numbers to 10,000
- Round to nearest 10,100 and 1000
- Roman numerals

Addition and subtraction:

- Add two 4-digit numbers
- Add two 4-digit numbers with exchanging
- Subtract two 4-digit numbers
- Subtract two 4-digit numbers with exchanging

Music

In music, we will be looking at musical structures. The children will work on copying rhythms using body percussion and instruments. They will learn to understand some formal, written notation and they will begin to perform using varied note lengths. They will learn to move in time with a beat.

Computing

Learners will apply their knowledge and understanding of networks, to appreciate the internet as a network of networks which need to be kept secure. They will learn that the World Wide Web is part of the internet, and will be given opportunities to explore the World Wide Web for themselves in order to learn about who owns content and what they can access, add, and create. Finally, they will evaluate online content to decide how honest, accurate, or reliable it is, and understand the consequences of false information.
