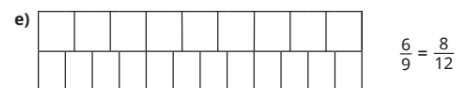
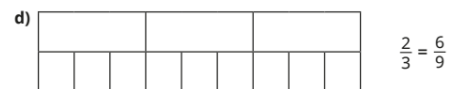
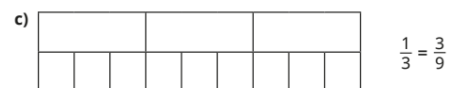
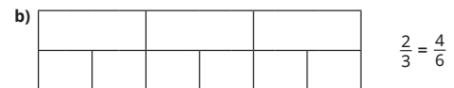
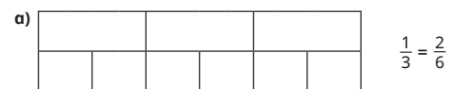
## Maths

This week in maths, we learnt how to identify equivalent fractions on a number line and on a bar model. We have started relating fractions to multiplication and division.

2 Shade the bar models to show the equivalent fractions.



The children are beginning to see that if the numerator and the denominator are either multiplied or divided by the same number, we get equivalent fractions.

## English

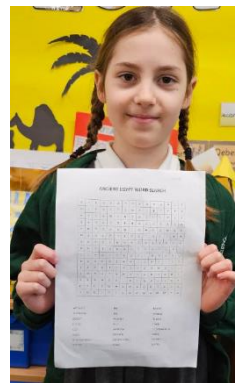
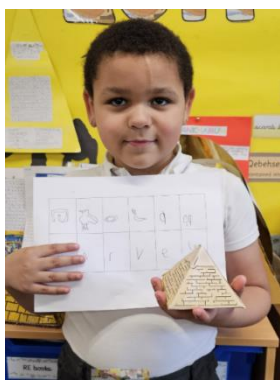
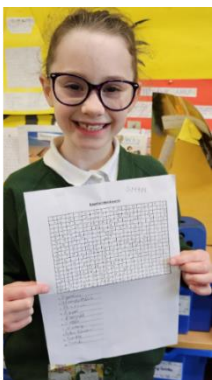
In our English lessons this week, we completed our non-chronological report and we have written a recount of the events of our school trip to Kent Life Farm.
