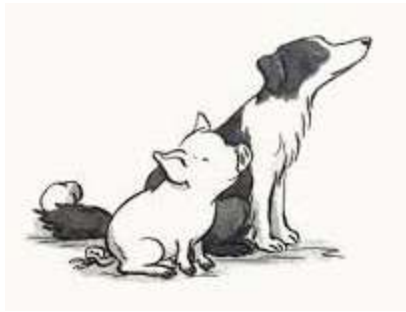


Year 3 Newsletter

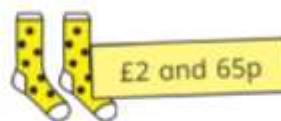

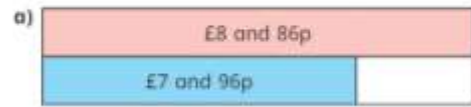
