Maths:

In Maths, we have been learning about decimals, fractions and percentages. The children have been adding and subtracting decimal numbers and they have also been partitioning numbers in order to better understand the role of place value. Later in the week, the children learnt about percentages and how to find percentages of numbers. Additionally, they were challenged to answer some tricky reasoning questions.

English:

In English we have continued reading our class book, *The London Eye Mystery*. After some acting and note-taking, the children wrote a formal police report.
