Maths:

This week, the children continued to learn about long division - this time with remainders and how to interpret them. Later in the week, the children learnt about multiples, factors and prime numbers. They have also been working on having a quick recall of the times tables, as this is hugely important in year 6. Please encourage your son/daughter to use TT Rockstars regularly at home, in order to keep the knowledge fresh in their minds.

English:

This week, we continued our class book, *Letters from the Lighthouse*. The children wrote a recount about starting a new school and had to be very imaginative - they invented several unfortunate events that happened to them on their first day. I thoroughly enjoyed reading their writing. In addition, they wrote a piece describing emotions using abstract nouns - they did this very effectively! Well done all.

PE:

In PE, the children continued practising their rugby skills. They practised passing and played a game.

RE:

In RE, the children wrote a creation poem, focusing on the senses - what they could see, hear, feel, taste and how that makes them feel.

Art:
