Stars of the week

Maths:

This week, the children have been adding and subtracting using a formal written method. They have also been solving word problems and reasoning questions.

English:

We have continued reading our class book, Letters from the Lighthouse. This week, the children answered comprehension questions; they also wrote a descriptive piece about Budmouth Point - the village in Devon the children were evacuated to. The children were challenged to show and not tell the reader about the village - through using rich descriptive words and phrases.

Science:

The children investigated reflection in Science this week. In groups, they tested which materials were reflective and which were non-reflective. They were then challenged to use scientific vocabulary when writing up their conclusion.

Italian:

The children revised the name of the days, months and seasons. They also practised asking questions such as, 'What day is it?' and 'When is your birthday?' In addition, they were trying to build sentences in Italian using vocabulary known.

Latin:

In Latin, the children looked at how the verb-endings change according to the subject they are referring to. They also did this with adjectives.

RE:

The children studied Genesis 1, before annotating the text with their interpretations and questions. They were so engaged and offered some great questions and comments. Well done all!

Computing:

This week, the children investigated coding through trying to create their own mini-games.
