English:

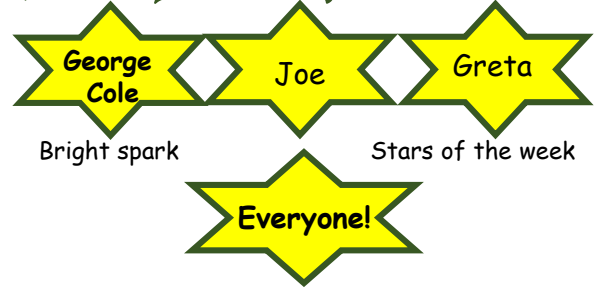

We have continued to practise a variety of reading comprehension skills and the children's understanding is developing well.

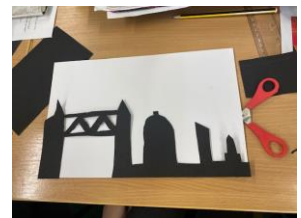
Maths:
