Stars of the week

English:

This week, the children wrote a conversation using both formal and informal language. They had to remember to use correct punctuation for speech. Some children shared their writing; it was lovely to hear how they had used their imagination to great effect.

The children have also practised some of the reading comprehension skills.

In addition, they have been using suffixes to make adjectives from nouns.

Maths:

In maths, we have been revising a variety of different areas. This week, we have covered: fractions, 3D shapes, ratio, proportions, length, height and weight.

Geography:

In geography, the children learnt how rivers erode, transport and deposit materials. They then produced a fact file about what they had learnt.

RE:

In RE, the children found out that Buddhism is often seen as a 'philosophy of life', rather than a religion. They learnt that Buddhism teaches people to: lead a moral life, to be mindful and aware of thoughts and actions and the importance to develop wisdom and understanding.

Italian:

In Italian, the children are practising translating texts from Italian to English.

PE:

The children practised their gymnastic skills this week. They also continued to practise batting, catching and throwing, before playing a game of rounders.
