## A snapshot of our week



### Thank you

### English:

The children have been very busy writing this week! On Monday, we completed the complaints letter that we started last week. The children then wrote a detailed character description of the main character, Ted, in our class book. Later in the week, the children wrote a descriptive recount of a storm - this was based on the opening scene of Shakespeare's 'The Tempest'.

### PE:

The children enjoyed a muddy and wet football session with Mrs Vennart this week. Please ensure your son/daughter has the appropriate kit available in school on Tuesdays. I will remind the children to take the kit home to be washed when the weather is like it was during their session.

### Art:

In art, the children enjoyed drawing The London Eye



### Maths:

In maths, the children have been learning about co-ordinates. They have been translating and reflecting shapes. We have also been working on decimal numbers - focusing on place value to identify the value of digits given.

### Geography:

We have started our geography topic, Fairtrade. First, the children worked with determination to match our topic vocabulary with their meanings. We also talked about what Fairtrade is and how it works.

### RE:

In RE, the children learnt about The Gospels. They found out that they were written to present the life and teachings of Jesus in ways that would be appropriate to different readers, and for that reason are not all the same. The children then worked with determination and perseverance to try to interpret some of Jesus' teachings - then had to summarise the teaching in seven words or less - they were totally awesome at doing this!
