

# Year 6 news

Term 2, Week 2

## Maths:

This week, we have started our unit on fractions. The children have been simplifying fractions by dividing the numerator and denominator by the same number. They have also been learning how to decide which fraction is bigger by finding a common numerator. The children have also worked on their arithmetic skills.

## Latin:

In Latin, the children read a text, before translating it to English. They also filled in the missing verbs in sentences.

## RE:

This term, we are studying the concept, Incarnation. The key question for the term is, 'Was Jesus the Messiah?'. The children first discussed what a Messiah is, before considering a Christian's view about the Messiah. They found out that Christians believe that Jesus is the Messiah because there is evidence that Jesus is:

- A descendant from King David
- Born in Bethlehem
- A special person sent by God
- Someone to make Israel great again
