

## Mathematics

### Addition and Subtraction:

Represent and use number bonds and related subtraction facts within 10, read, write and interpret mathematical statements involving addition (+), subtraction (-) and equals (=) sign, add and subtract one-digit numbers to 10, including zero, solve one step problems that involve addition and subtraction, using concrete objects and pictorial representations and missing number problems.

## Italian

With Mrs Ward this term, we will be revising different animals and colours. We will also count to 10 and revisit the days of the week.

## Science

For our science topic this term, the children will be learning about the four seasons and the weather associated with each season. They will be observing the weather on a daily basis and recording temperature and rainfall. We will collect and evaluate the data and transfer it into bar graphs and tables. Due to the nature of this topic, we will continue to observe the changes in the seasons and weather throughout the year on an on-going basis. We will also continue our learning of the senses that we have and conduct different experiments with some of these.

## Year 1 Term Two Autumn

### Seasonal Change and Weather

## RE

The children will learn the story of Jesus' birth and begin to understand why Jesus is important to Christians. They will be introduced to the Gospels and understand that stories of Jesus' life come from the Gospels. We will discuss how Christians use the story of the Nativity to guide their beliefs and actions at Christmas. We will also consider how we can be thankful at Christmas time.

## Music

The children will continue to follow the Charanga music scheme. This term's theme is to revisit what pulse, rhythm and pitch mean. We will also be learning to sing and rap. The children will learn that they can make different types of sounds with their voices – you can rap or say words in rhythm.

## PSHE

In PSHE we will be thinking about Friendships. We will be discussing what it means to be a good friend and how we can help other people who are in trouble. We will also learn about how different religions worship different Gods and learn about some of their festivals such as the Hindu festival of Diwali.

## English

Our English learning will be based around ourselves and the farm. We focus on the book 'What a ladybird heard' by Julia Donaldson. We will focus on ensuring our writing is constructed correctly using capital letters at the beginning of sentences and for names, including full stops and finger spaces. We will continue to ensure we use phonic sounds in our writing to segment words we are unsure of. We will also be writing our letters in the correct formation through lots of handwriting practice. For phonics, we will revise and reinforce sounds learnt in Reception and look at alternative graphemes.

## PE

We will be focusing on gymnastics and circuits. Introducing coordination and looking at what parts of their body they can use to balance with. We will be learning gymnastics poses such as the pike, straddle and tuck.

## Computing

We will be learning the basics of using a computer first. How to turn it on, move the mouse around, click and drag on objects. We will then be looking at how to log in to Purple Mash safely and create our first document. We will look at how to save our learning and access it the follow lesson to edit and improve our learning. We will be learning how to safely turn off a computer and ensure that they are put away correctly.
