

Mathematics

In maths this term, children will study graphs. They will learn to interpret and present data in different ways, for example, in tally charts, bar graphs and pictograms. Children will discover that a chart is a simple and effective way to represent data.

In addition to graphs, the children will also learn about weight and capacity. They will use appropriate scales for measurements and learn to use mixed units, like kg and g. They will compare, add, subtract and solve problems on mass and volume.

Home Learning: Times tables linked to the weekly times tables test.

English

SPaG will continue to run through every lesson in English, with a focus on ways of improving the quality of written work. The children will learn the correct tense forms of verbs - past, present, future, past perfect and present perfect. They will complete weekly reading comprehension activities.

The children will learn how to write an information text which will be based on their favourite animal. They will look at the features of these texts and build up to writing their own.

Home Learning: Practise spellings and read daily.

RE

In RE, children will make suggestions for what the texts about the entry into Jerusalem, and the death and resurrection of Jesus might mean. Throughout the unit, children will think about what texts studied mean to Christians today. We will make simple links between Gospel texts and how Christians mark the Easter events in their church communities. Year Three will identify how Christians show their beliefs about Palm Sunday, Good Friday and Easter Sunday in worship.

Year 3 Term 4

Ancient Egypt

Forces and magnets

Science

This term, the children will be learning to compare and group together different kinds of rocks on the basis of their appearance and simple physical properties. They will learn how fossils are formed and that soils are made from rocks and organic matter. Children will have the opportunity to explore rock and soil samples from around the school.

Topic

The children will begin the term by continuing their learning on Ancient Egypt. They will think about the importance of the River Nile to the Egyptians and identify and name some Gods and Goddesses.

Italian

This term in Italian, the children will learn how to say and write *I like...* and *I don't like...* They will try to make up sentences using these sentences with names of food and drinks. All the children will also practice simple sentences that will enable them to have a basic conversation. They will also complete some Easter activities.

PSHE

In PSHE, the children learn about communication, through a wide range of stories and activities. They will look at the different ways there are to communicate and who they can ask for help when needed. We will re-cap dealing with emotions and finding ways to vocalise them correctly.

PE

In PE, the children will carry out a unit on dance. They will learn to create a pattern of timed movements and sequences. Alongside this, children will work on their throwing and catching abilities in a weekly outdoor lesson.

Computing

In Term 4, children will learn how to communicate safely online using emails. They will compose, send and receive emails in Purple Mash.
