### Synonyms

A word that has the same ( or nearly the same meaning) as another word. EXP: Funny - Comical

### <u>Antonyms</u>

A word with the opposite meaning. EXP: Sad ~ Happy

### Pre-fix

A group of letters at the start of the word that changes its meaning. EXP:

Root word - like Prefix ~ dis

= Díslíke

Common exp: un, dis, in, pre, anti. Suffix

A group of letters at the end of a root word. EXP:

Root word ~ beauty Suffix ~ ful = Beautiful

Common exp: ful, ness, ly, ment.
