Breakfast club

7.30am - 8.40am @ £4.50

Evidence shows that introducing elements of physical activity and play to children before school starts can engage their minds and prepare them for the day ahead.

The morning sessions will involve child led activities, children eating a healthy breakfast and having some organised active fun. Breakfast includes toast, cereals, fruit, yoghurts, juice and water.

The breakfast club enables working parents to drop their child off over an hour before the start of school, enabling them to get to work on time.

Dropping off your child

When dropping off your child, you must enter through the playground gate and walk your child to the school hall door. Here you will be met by our Breakfast Club manager and registered into the club.

Please note breakfast will start to be served at 7.45am with the playground gate locked at 8am each day. Should you turn up after 8am please call our club phone.

After-school club

A trusted space where children can play and learn under the supervision of highly qualified, caring staff.

Activities such as arts & crafts, a range of sports, dance, games, gardening, construction, woodland adventures and general free play will create a termly timetable.

The timetable is a well-rounded mix of wellbeing, activity and arts - with an emphasis of fun and inclusion to give the children variety and help them enjoy their time with us.

Children will have the choice to take part in a range of activities each day and a chance for free play.

Food and drink

Children attending the 3.15pm-4.30pm session are invited to bring along a healthy snack which they can have during registration period.

Children attending either the 4.15pm-6pm session or the 3.15pm-6pm session will be served a light tea at 4.45pm. This will include options such as sandwiches, pittas, wraps, fillings, fresh fruit, veg etc



Collecting your child

When collecting your child, you must come to the school playground gate, call our club phone and notify us who you wish to collect.

A member of staff will walk your child to the gate, along with all of their belongings and your child will be released from our care.



Our process for you to follow when making your Childcare Voucher/Tax Free Childcare booking:

1. Make your booking online with Premier Education remembering to select the 'Paying with Childcare voucher' box when checking out.
2. You will receive a booking confirmation email confirming the total amount of that booking.
3. Log into your Childcare Voucher/Tax Free Childcare account and transfer the correct amount to Premier Education.
4. This will then be processed, and we should receive the payment within 3 working days. If your provider does not appear on this list, please contact: mkoffice@premier-education.com


